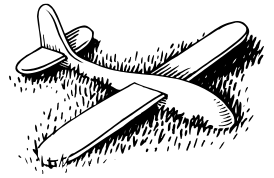


Plant 2 Glider History

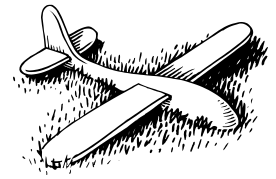


1. UNIVAC/Sperry/UNISYS Plant 2 was the original **Engineering Research Associates** facility; located at 1902 Minnehaha Avenue in St. Paul, MN.
 2. Before ERA, this facility was a **Northwestern Aeronautical Corporation** glider manufacturing plant.
 3. John Parker was the **NAC** owner and first **ERA** President and financier.
 4. **NAC** was the 2nd largest WWII builder of the **CG-4A** glider.
- The **CG-4A** glider is commemorated in a Normandy, France museum and at the **Fagen WW II Museum** in Granite Falls, Minnesota
 - **Gish Devlaminck**, a VIP Club member, has visited both museums.

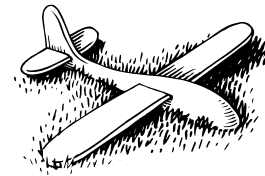

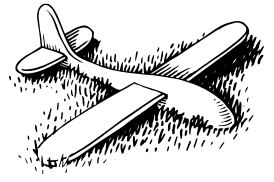

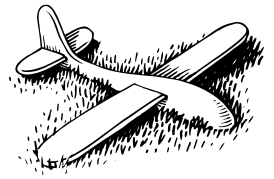
CG-4A Glider

Villaume Industries in Eagan, MN - 2009/12**

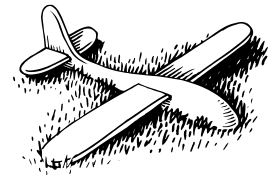


CG-4A Cockpit

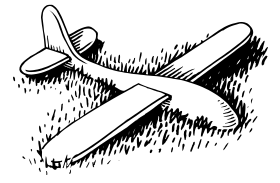


- Troop Capacity 13 with their equipment

CG-4A Inside Views

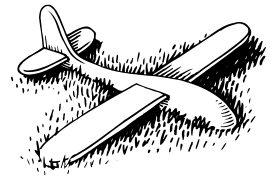

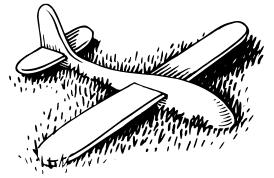


North American Aviation P-51 Mustang
